Most of you do not need a visa for Georgia at all (citizens of EU countries, USA, Japan, Israel, Turkey, Canada, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Moldova, Ukraine, etc.). Citizens of some countries, including citizens of Russia, can obtain a visa while crossing the border of Georgia at official checkpoints, including all airports of Georgia, but excluding checkpoint Larsi, between Vladikavkaz (North Osetia) and Stepantsminda (former Kazbegi, Georgia).

The program will include excursions to the beautiful surroundings of Batumi, museums, ancient churches, and castles.
