Visa information: Visa affair is the easiest part of the travel. Citizens of many countries do not need an entrance visa for Georgia (citizens of EU countries, USA, Japan, Israel, Turkey, Canada, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Moldova, Ukraine, etc.). Citizens of some countries, including citizens of Russia, can obtain a visa while crossing the border of Georgia at official checkpoints,

including all airports of Georgia, but excluding checkpoint Larsi, between Vladikavkaz (North Osetia) and Stephantsminda (former Kazbegi, Georgia).

Travel information: Batumi can be reached both from **Tbilisi** and from **Istanbul** by airplane (daily flights in Summer). The airport is very close to the city. Batumi is about 350 km west from Tbilisi, about 6 hours by train, bus, or car.
