Dear colleagues,

We have already informed You that **September 12 to 19, 2010** Georgian Mathematical Union organizes the First Annual Conference **in Batumi,** a Black sea resort of Georgia. The Conference will be held in the modern and beautiful building of Batumi State University.

Orgainizing Workshops etc.

The Conference will be compiled of Workshops, Sessions, Seminars and Schools. The exact program will be announced after the deadline of organizing Workshops, Session and Schools expires.

To those who would like to organize Workshops, Sessions, Seminars or Schools we kindly ask to send us first the detailed information and tentative list of participants **until May 15**. Later we will ask for confirmation from participants.

Today we can only confirm the following Workshops:

- Function spaces and approximation (U. Goginava)
- Mathematical Education and History (G. Gogishvili, T. Vepkhvadze)
- Mathematical modeling and Numerical analysis (T. Chilachava, D. Gordeziani, H. Meladze)
- Mechanics of Continua (R. Bancuri, G. Jaiani, J. Sharikadze)
- Partial Differential Equations and Applications (R.Duduchava, D. Natroshvili)
- Theoretical (Mathematical) physics (A. Kvinikhidze)

Registration Fee

Registration fee is 120 Euro which includes 7 nights in hotel in a double room. After July 31 the conference fee would raise to 150 Euro and we can not guarantee the same prices for hotels. We will inform you about new prices after August 1.

Accompanying persons are free of charge, but have to pay for hotel, excursions and meals.

We have applied for a financial support (grants for travel and local costs) to the governmental and private foundations, but have not succeeded so far. A limited number of participants will get a financial support for local expenses. Unfortunately we are not capable to cover any travel costs from abroad.

Accomodation

We have reserved for participants about 200 beds in following hotels, which are rather modern and comfortable, all of them with individual facilities:

Prices for the reserved hotels are 25 Georgian Lari (equivalent approx. 11 Euro) 1 person /1 night/ double bed room, including breakfast or 50 Georgian Lari 1 person /1 night/ single room, including breakfast (excluding breakfast in "Liza" & "Eva").

Those who want to get an alternative hotel or a single room will be refunded 150 GEL. There are many other hotels in Batumi and surroundings, including 5 star "Sheraton" and 4 Star "Intourist" (prices 150-300 USD room/night) and other comfortable hotels with a range of prices from 60 USD). Transportation

Batumi can be reached both from Tbilisi and from Istanbul (daily flights in Summer). The airport is close to the city. Batumi is about 350 km west from Tbilisi, about 6-7 hours by train or a car.

Visa

Visa affair is the easiest part of the travel. Most of you do not need a visa for Georgia at all (citizens of EU countries, USA, Japan, Israel, Turkey, Canada, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Moldova etc.). All remainders (including citizens of Russia) can apply for visa and obtain it while crossing the border of Georgia at official checkpoints, including all airports of Georgia and excluding a sole checkpoint at Larsi, directly on the border of Georgia With Russia (North Osetia).

Cultural program

The program will include excursions in the beautiful surroundings of Batumi. You can visit museums, ancient churches and castles.

It is worth mentioning that Batumi is the most rapidly developing city in Georgia and had changed a lot during the past 5-6 years. Weather at that time is very warm (the "velvet" season) and it is a great pleasure to swim in the Black sea.
